Purpose of the role

To work as part of a close team that maintain the racing surface and associated areas at Goodwood Racecourse in line with British Horseracing Authority standards and to a level to attract the best horses in the World.

The role will also involve maintenance and presentation of the public areas to the highest possible level.

You will be expected to work outside in varying weather conditions on jobs that can be physically demanding. There will also be weekend/Bank Holiday/evening work requirements.

Key responsibilities

- Maintenance of the racing surface (including, but not limited to; tractor work, mowing, strimming)
- Movement of running rail
- Maintenance of Parade and Pre Parade Rings, lawns, public areas and car parks
- Irrigation of the racing surface and lawns
- Locking and unlocking of buildings
- Any other duties as required
- Compliance with all Health and Safety and Goodwood internal policies
