- Work with the H&S Manager for aspects of fire safety management including the carrying out of Fire Risk Assessments, ensuring the process is seen through to completion.
- Assist with safety inspections, carried out, fire drills.

- Assist with and monitor audits and checks.
- Keep up to date with all aspects of relevant health, safety, fire, environment & welfare at work legislation.
- Attend meetings as and when required to report on relevant health & safety matters.
- Be flexible and confident working across a multi discipline environment.
- Work on a rota system when required for our sporting events.
- Be part of an on-call rota system for effective management of the 365 business.
- Be confident with the risk register and salvage plan.
- Monitor and report on the status of outstanding actions and supporting and advising managers to achieve completion
- Any other reasonable duties which may be required by H&S Manager.
